

# FACILITIES

26 ACRES OF WOODLAND PROPERTY ON THE NORTH SHORE OF THE LONG ISLAND SOUND

Renovations to meeting spaces in 2012 include new handicapped facilities and bathrooms!



**Outdoor Swimming Pool:** Seasonal use for instruction and recreation, lighted for night-time use.

**Sports:** Playing field, basketball courts, volleyball and badminton. Picnic areas available.

**Father John Davis Hall:** A spacious facility for 150 guests with fireplace and family-style food service for overnight guests.

**Conference and Meeting Hall:** A multi-purpose space for 150 guests with large fireplace, Wi-fi access, dividable spaces and classrooms for small group use.

**Arts and Crafts Classroom** for 30 guests.

**Nature Classroom** for 20 guests.

**Challenge Course:** High Ropes Elements with Climbing Wall and Low Ropes Elements, for group team building and community sessions.

**St Luke's Chapel:** A place for worship, prayer and fellowship for 150 guests with scenic waterfront views, among shade trees, lawn and gardens.

**1/4 mile beach-front property:** A wooded trail leading to the beach and waterfront for swimming, sailing, canoeing, camp fires, fishing and other water activities.

**TEMPUR-PEDIC**  
All accommodations now include tempur-pedic mattresses.

**Cabins:** Eight heated cabins, each accommodating twelve guests, include bathroom facilities with two separate shower buildings nearby. Two additional heated cabins, each accommodating eight guests, and ten summer cabins, each accommodating from four to eight guests. \$75 per person per night including three meals.

**Retreat Lodge:** Three-bedroom, one level house with full bathroom, full kitchen and living room. \$85 per night per person including three meals.

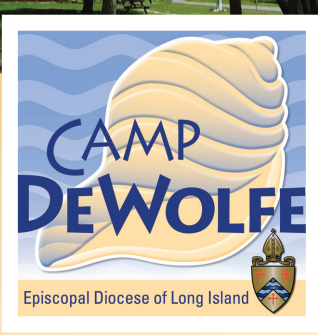

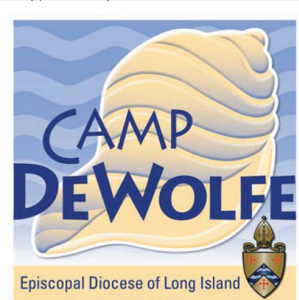
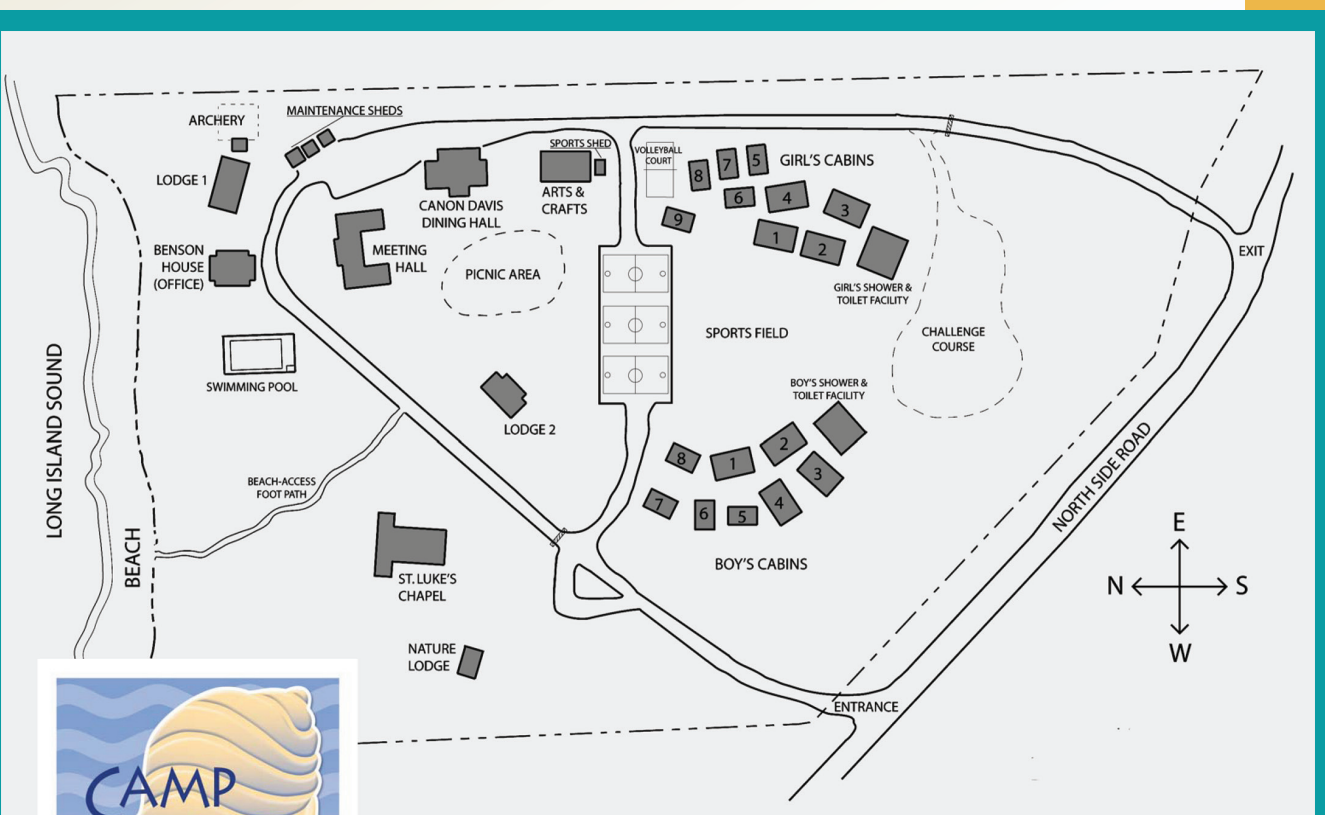
## From Western Long Island, via the Long Island Expressway (495):

- Take LIE Exit 68 to William Floyd Parkway (Highway 46) North.
- Bear RIGHT at end of William Floyd Parkway onto Route 25A East.
- Continue on Route 25A.
- Turn LEFT at the light by the HESS Gas Station onto Wading River Manor Road.
- Bear LEFT at the end of the road onto North Country Road.
- Make a quick sharp RIGHT at the fire department onto North Wading River Road.
- Turn LEFT at the green sign for the camps, onto North Side Road.
- Turn RIGHT at the sign for Camp DeWolfe.

## From Eastern Long Island, From Riverhead:

- Take Route 25 West.
- Turn RIGHT onto Route 25A West at the Sunoco Gas Station.
- Continue on Route 25A.
- Turn RIGHT at the light by the HESS Gas Station onto Wading River Manor Road.
- Bear LEFT at the end of the road onto North Country Road.
- Make a sharp RIGHT at the fire department onto North Wading River Road.
- Turn LEFT at the green sign for the camps, onto North Side Road.
- Turn RIGHT at the sign for Camp DeWolfe.
