



DID YOU KNOW?

In January 1942, "Operation Bodyguard" began in what is now known as "Benson House" at Camp DeWolfe. Federal Agents, posing as German spies, used the house as a radio station to send false information to the German high command. This campaign contributed to the success of the Normandy invasion on June 6th, 1944, the beginning of the end of WWII in Europe. In 2014, on the 70th Anniversary of D-Day, over 100 guests and members of the "Society of Former FBI Agents" dedicated Benson House, in appreciation of the agents who carried out their mission here and the historical significance to WWII.
