# ACCOMMODATIONS & FACILITIES



**BENSON HOUSE:** An historic, three-story house overlooking the Long Island Sound. Suitable for all groups, Benson house has nine bedrooms (17 beds), four full bathrooms, full kitchen, linen service and back porch complete with spectacular views.

**RETREAT LODGE:** One-level house with four bedrooms, two full bathrooms and kitchenette. Sleeps 16 guests in bunk bed accommodations.

**CABINS:** Eight cabins with heat and air-conditioning. Each cabin accommodates eight guests and includes bathroom facilities with separate shower buildings nearby. Two additional heated cabins sleep eight guests.

**ST LUKE'S CHAPEL:** 69' x 29'. A multiuse facility with Sound front views. The Chapel is designed for all types of worship, prayer, meetings and fellowship for up to 150 guests.

**FR. JOHN DAVIS HALL:** 59' x 40'. A spacious dining facility for 150 guests. Meals are prepared and served at 8am, 12pm and 5pm. Davis Hall also boasts a large fireplace and is situated near the center of camp.

**DEWOLFE HALL:** 82' x 30'. A multipurpose space for up to 150 guests. The room can be subdivided and has a classroom attached for small group meetings. DeWolfe Hall is Wi-Fi enabled.

**ARTS AND CRAFTS CLASSROOM:** Breakout space for up to 30 guests. Classroom is heated and has bathroom facilities.

**SWIMMING POOL:** Open seasonally and can be booked for an additional fee. Lighted for nighttime use.

**SPORTS:** Sports fields include softball backstop, volleyball, soccer, gaga ball and three basketball courts.

**CAMPFIRES:** Three campfire sites are available for reservation and come prepared with logs ready for use!

**LONG ISLAND SOUND:** ¼ mile private beach access to the Long Island Sound. A beach trail descends down to the waterfront for all types of water-based activities!

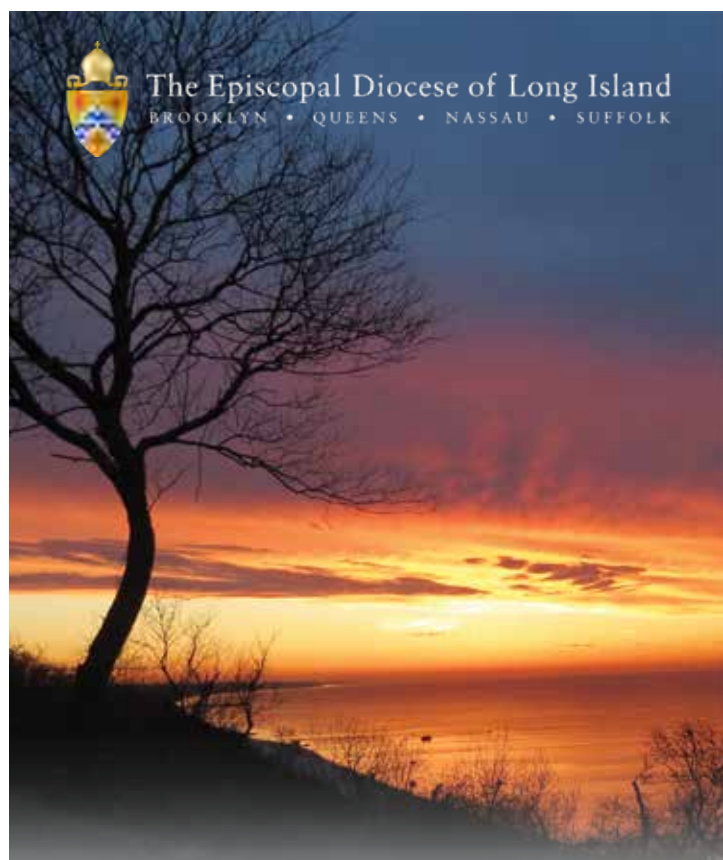

## DIRECTIONS:

**From Western Long Island, via the Long Island Expressway (495):** Take LIE Exit 68 to William Floyd Parkway (Highway 46) North. Bear RIGHT at end of William Floyd Parkway onto Route 25A East. Continue on Route 25A. Turn LEFT at the light by the speedway onto Wading River Manor Road. Bear LEFT at the end of the road onto North Country Road. Make a quick sharp RIGHT at the fire department onto North Wading River Road. Turn LEFT at the green sign for the camps, onto North Side Road. Turn RIGHT at the sign for Camp DeWolfe.

**From Eastern Long Island, From Riverhead:** Take Route 25 West. Turn RIGHT onto Route 25A West at the Sunoco Gas Station. Continue on Route 25A. Turn RIGHT at the light by the speedway onto Wading River Manor Road. Bear LEFT at the end of the road onto North Country Road. Make a sharp RIGHT at the fire department onto North Wading River Road. Turn LEFT at the green sign for the camps, onto North Side Road. Turn RIGHT at the sign for Camp DeWolfe.
